Superintendent Principe presented an overview of the proposed budgets. The Agency has 3 funds: Operating, Capital and Special Revenue. We are projecting a deficit in the Operating Fund for next year of \$363,308. In the Capital Fund we are projecting an excess of \$45,000 with the intention of bringing the reserve up after flood related expenses. The Special Revenue is for scholarships with a spend down of \$20,000 per year. The Long Range Plan includes a replacement schedule for building, vehicles and equipment. At the March Board meeting there will be a PowerPoint and a deeper dive into the proposed budget. - Administration Superintendent Principe reported:
 - The packet contains a chart of information needed from the member districts for budgeting purposes.
- **Recreation** Superintendent Meyer reported:
 - The six new Unified Bowling teams competed in Special Olympics and one took gold and will travel to Peoria for the state bowling tournament
 - Special Olympics Jr. Wildcats team too first place and will head to State in March
 - We have had great success with a 1-on-1 Rec & Roll participant and will be opening the program up to more 1-on-1.
 - Sixteen Timothy Christian High School students volunteered at five Rec & Roll sites in January
 - January is recruitment month at local high schools. Many good connections were made and applications are being received.
 - Brook LaRocco was hired for the Program Team
 - We are hosting 2 interns for winter and spring
- Inclusion and Risk Management Superintendent Kerrins reported:
 - Inclusion numbers are up from the prior year and up 50% since 2022.
 - Kudos to the Park Districts for being welcoming to special needs families which has spurred the growth in Inclusion.
 - Inclusion families were surveyed after the fall sessions and very positive feedback was received.
 - Kelly Pankey was hired as a 19-hour assistant in Naperville.
 - Two trainings were held in January for Park District staff
- **Communications and Development** Superintendent Jackman reported:
 - We are finishing the year strong.

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- Thank you to everyone for their Bash responses. We have filled 446 of the 450 available seats.
- We are certain that we will achieve our goal of raising the \$750,000 for the Scholarship Endowment in our anniversary year of 2026.
- Final numbers for the 2024 Annual Appeal are just over \$82,000, which is up \$10,000 from the previous year. The average gift was up \$100 and there were 16 new donors.
- We have 3 openings for Trustees on the Board with 2 people interested in joining.
- Two large donations have been recently received: \$162,597.29 from an estate and \$45,000 from the FJK Foundation.
